COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Postulates, principles, the accounting cycle, capital and income measurement, financial statement preparation and analysis, emphasis on reports to shareholders, creditors and other external decision makers.

Emphasis is placed on understanding through individual student study, homework assignments and tutorials. The material is integrative (ideas learned initially are re-stated throughout the term), it is therefore essential that the student remain current.

OBJECTIVES:

- 1) To provide students with a solid, basic understanding of the structure of financial accounting and its use in the business environment.
- 2) To develop some understanding of the concepts that embody financial accounting so that students may be able to apply the concepts in seeking solutions to "real world" problems.
